

Conditions of Use

All deposits must be paid at the time of booking, quoting the booking reference.

Use of Campsite

Site, including HQ building, kitchen and toilet/shower block must be thoroughly cleaned before leaving by each group.
All rubbish must be taken with you on leaving the site. **Additional rubbish bags are provided to help with this.**

No fires on the grass – please use the fire circle or within an altar fire.
Please return all unused firewood to the wood pile.

No dogs allowed on site.
No holes or pits may be dug.
No vehicles allowed on the field without permission.
Please do not wash cooking utensils in the toilet block.
No smoking on any part of the site.

Activities

The appropriate safety rules, as laid down in [Policy Organisation and Rules](#) must be followed for all activities at the campsite. Leaders are responsible for the safety and supervision of their members at all times.

Risk assessments for all activities carried out must be undertaken by the leader in charge.

The use of activities on site are only permitted when specifically booked and under authorised supervision.

No water activities shall take place above or below the river weir within the safety boom upstream of the weir and the end of the wall below.

The site's decision on all activities taking place is final.

Lights out must not be later than 11.00pm. Night activities must have the site's prior approval.

General

The Bedford and Ouse Valley District Scout Council will not be responsible for any loss or damage to vehicles, cycles, equipment, or personal effects left or used at the campsite.

The Scout Association [smoking](#) and [alcohol](#) policies must be adhered to.

Please note the site does not have a television licence or licence to play music on site if this is required, individual groups must apply for a licence from the Performing Rights Society.
